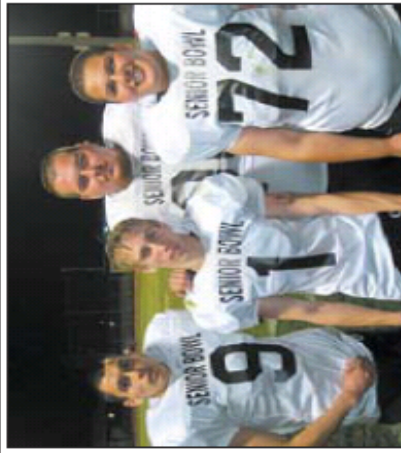

Apache Trail, Imagine Prep Represented At AZCAA Senior Bowl

The Arizona Charter Athletic Association (AzCAA) hosted its inaugural "Senior Bowl" on Saturday, January 22 at Phoenix Christian High School and both Apache Trail High School and Imagine Prep @Superstition charter schools were represented in the eight-man tackle football All-Star game.

Wide receiver Jon Bohn, defensive back/linebacker Daniel Sepulveda and lineman Angel Ortiz of the Apache Trail Wolfpack, and lineman Bryce Gardner of the Imagine Prep Panthers all played for the "East" team that ended up winning the Senior Bowl 20-14 over the West team.

Bohn, Sepulveda, Ortiz and Gardner all played together on the 2009 AzCAA Class "B" State Championship

team from Apache Trail HS but Gardner transferred over to Imagine Prep his senior year to play for the Panthers inaugural season of eight-man tackle football.

All four A.J. players also had several key plays at the Senior Bowl, including a huge sack and several tackles from Gardner, a touchdown-saving tackle on special teams from Bohn, and key tackles and blocks from Sepulveda and Ortiz.

Another player at the Senior Bowl from Apache Junction was the East squad's quarterback Brandon McCormick, who played at Sequoia High School in Mesa where his father is the athletic director. McCormick was named the offensive MVP of the inaugural Senior Bowl.
